Entries: Online entries (see notes below).

\$7.00 per event.

Entry times can be long course or short course times.

Swimmers are limited to two events.

Swimmers should only enter one event per 200m form stroke block as heats may be combined.

NOTE 200m events: 100m times are being used as the qualifying times to enter the 200m events. The following qualifying times apply:

Each swimmer must provide at least 1 official (i.e. lap turning/timekeeper) where their parent/s is not already officiating at the meet.

There will be four meets in the 2018 ACT Winter Distance Series - all at the AIS:

Meet 1: Sunday 6 May

Meet 2: Sunday 3 June

Meet 3: Sunday 1 July

Meet 4: Sunday 19 August

The distance meets will be swum following each of the Winter Development Series Meets.

NOTE Events 63 to 66: These events appear twice in the online entry system. Firstly as the actual event with the associated qualifying time, then as the event number followed by an A where the swimmer is entering using the alternate distance qualifying time. For example, 66A 11 & over 400m freestyle is actually the 800m freestyle entered using the 400m qualifying time of 5:55.00. Similarly, 65A 13 & over 800m freestyle is the 1500m event entered using the 800m qualifying time of 11:42.00. Please ensure that you enter the correct event for the distance you intend to swim i.e. if you intend to swim the 800m freestyle you need to enter either event 66 or 66A.

Normal pool entry applies to swimmers and spectators.

Swimming ACT approved. Swimming NSW rules apply.
