DECLARATION

- 1 I, the undersigned, in consideration of and as a condition of acceptance of my entry in the event for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators hereby waive all and any claim, right or cause of action which I or they might otherwise have for or arising out of my loss of life, damage or loss of any description whatsoever which I may suffer or sustain in the course of or consequent upon my entry or participation in the said event **AND** I admit that I participate in the said event solely at my own risk.

- 2 This waiver, release and discharge shall be and operate separately in favour of all persons, corporations and bodies involved or otherwise engaged in promoting or staging the event and the servants, agents, representatives and officers of them and includes but is not limited to Telopea Swimming Club Inc. medical and paramedical personnel, police officers and shall operate whether or not the loss, injury or damage is attributable to the act or neglect of any one or more of them.

- 3 I hereby acknowledge that I have sole responsibility for my personal possessions and swimming equipment during the event.

- 4 I hereby attest and verify that I am physically fit and have sufficiently trained for this event. If requested, I agree to provide with my entry form a signed doctor's certificate attesting to my physical fitness to participate in the said event.

- 5 I hereby consent to receive medical treatment, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident and/or illness during the event.

- 6 I hereby agree that in the event of cancellation due to storm, rain, inclement weather, winds or other 'Acts of God' conditions my entry fee shall be non refundable. I also agree that in the event of cancellation, the event organisers have the right to reschedule the event to another day of their choosing.

- 7 In the event that I exceed the nominated time limit and have not completed the course. I agree to leave the water when asked to by the officials or their representatives conducting the event.

- 8 I have read the Rules and these Conditions of Entry and agree to abide by them.

INFORMATION SHEET

TELOPEA OPEN WATER CARNIVAL

(2.5 km, 5Km swim through to 10km)

The event is being held Lake Burley Griffin, Alexandrina Drive and will Start and Finish within the same area.

All Competitors will swim the course as displayed on Board in Marshalling area. Full Referee instructions including directions of the Course will be given 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the event – this will be in the Marshalling area.

START: Events will Start at **10.30am sharp** and **late entries will close at 9:40am**. You will not be permitted to enter the water if you miss the Start.

RULES:

- 1 Entry forms and declaration must be fully completed and signed.
- 2 Competitors must keep within the defined course as instructed.
- 3 Age as at the day of the Event.
 - Minimum age for 5km is 12yrs (turning 13 for Australian Age) .
 - Minimum age for 10km is 13yrs (turning 14 for Australian Age)
- 4 Competitors must complete the course unassisted – Handlers/Support Craft are permitted – This must not be a powered craft.
- 5 Competitors leaving the water before the Finish will be deemed as failing to complete the course.
COMPETITORS FAILING TO COMPLETE THE COURSE MUST REPORT TO THE RECORDING MARQUEE SITUATED ON THE LAKE EDGE. THIS REQUIREMENT IS MANDATORY - PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE AREA WITHOUT REPORTING TO THE RECORDERS.
- 6 Competitors must ensure that as they pass through the Finish Line 'TO TOUCH AND CALL OUT THEIR COMPETITOR NUMBER' otherwise their place in the field or the time which they swam may be incorrect - IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT YOUR NUMBER IS HEARD BY THE JUDGES AS YOU FINISH. You have not completed the Event until your Number has been recorded
- 7 Competitors also to ensure that their Competitor Number is also recorded as they leave the water at the designated area.
- 8 Caps must be worn (caps supplied free when you report for Registration).
- 9 Power driven craft are prohibited from the course (except for Emergency Craft).
- 10 If in trouble, raise your arm and wait for help from one of the support craft or swim towards the shore.

Medals awarded to first three place getters in:

12 years & under, 13yrs , 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs 17 & over.

All 12& Under Swimmers completing their Event will receive a Certificate of Achievement.

RESULTS: Provisional results will be posted as they are finalised. Any queries on these results should then be directed to Recorders just inside the Recording Marquee.
